E. CHIEF SALVATORE'S REPORT

Chief Salvatore distributed the Monthly Statistics Report for November.

Chief Salvatore reported:

- He will speak to the Fox Meadow Board and ask them to remedy the situation that Ms. Kelly spoke of.
- The Senator Drive investigation was handed over to the State's Attorney's Office this morning for review.
- The Cider Hill investigation is not yet completed partly due to town staff not handing over requested documents in a timely manner. Just when they think that they are done, additional information comes in and they feel compelled to follow it up so a complete report will be turned in to the First Selectman.

- The process is moving forward with replacing the open Officer's position. They are in the background stage of the process.
- The yearly food drive was a huge success. Thousands of dollars of food was collected along with \$100.00 in gift cards and \$400.00 in cash. Chief Salvatore thanked all members of his department that participated.
- They applied for 3 warrants in the Cromwell Hills situation. One of the persons was arrested, one was denied and one is presently pending from the State's Attorney's Office. They didn't apply for the 4th warrant because the person could not be identified.

Ms. Halibozek asked for an update regarding the day-time break-ins. Ms. Halibozek asked when the spot will be run on Channel 3 that was being taped during the Food Drive.

First Selectman Flanders congratulated the department on the successful food drive. Mr. Flanders said they did an outstanding job.
