Northern Tier

STEAP Grant. A meeting with DECD is scheduled for tomorrow at 10 a.m. to get caught up to speed.

Joint Efforts with Rocky Hill.

Rte. 3 Corridor Study. Tighe & Bond have been engaged to conduct a study of the Route 3 Corridor. This study is being conducted through a grant from the Capital Region Council of Governments. The study will examine current and future traffic patterns. The Study will include anticipated growth in the Northern Tier, in the next 3, 5 and 10 years. Study will be kicked off on December 8.

Transfer Station Road. Rocky Hill is interested in the current status and future plans for this road.

Russo Property. Rocky Hill is working jointly with the owners of this property and their existing riverfront redevelopment area to attract new development. This area is adjacent to the TPC and the new practice facility. There may be opportunities for partnership.

Downtown. First Selectman has asked for assistance in developing a mechanism to provide grant funding to assist businesses. The first candidate for such assistance would be Melilli Cafe & Grill. Melilli's is seeking to improve their parking area. To facilitate the ability to provide such financial assistance it is recommended that the existing Economic Development Incentive Guidelines be followed. The business obviously fits the criteria under Section IV. 1. Downtown. And the grant can be offered if the application meets all other requirements, as stated in Section VII. A coordinated effort with the First Selectman's Office will be instituted to complete and application.
