E. CHIEF SALVATORE'S REPORT

The monthly statistics were distributed for June and July 2011.

Chief Salvatore introduced the newest Police Officer, Peter Peateratroia to the Board and thanked members of the Commission for attending the Swearing-In ceremony. A. Varricchio welcomed Officer Peateratroia on behalf of the Police Commission and offered his congratulations since he was working and unable to attend the ceremony. Chief Salvatore noted that Ms. Halibozek had called and sent her congratulations to the Officer because she was not able to attend.

Chief Salvatore informed the Board that Recruit Pam Young is doing very well at the Academy and Officer Tyler Meusel graduated from the academy last week and is now on the FTO program.

The renovations that were necessary due to the flooding are almost complete at the Police Department. Chief Salvatore gave kudos to Captain Kosinski and Al Clark for the outstanding job they did with the project.

The department is investigating several incidents of vandalism in town, houses and vehicles have been egged, and signs have been destroyed or stolen. They are setting up surveillance in several areas in town.

A. Halibozek spoke regarding an accident in front of the post office and asked about a traffic light at Evergreen and Main. Chief Salvatore said that the DOT will not install lights for that purpose since studies do not support a warrant. They looked at that area about a year ago. If the town installed a light it would cost approximately \$125,000.
