**E. CHIEF SALVATORE'S REPORT**

Chief Salvatore distributed the Monthly Incident Report for March.

Chief Salvatore introduced Cromwell's newest Officer, Pamela Young to the Police Commission and people in the audience. Chairman Newton and other members of the Commission welcomed Ms. Young and wished her well. She will enter the Academy on Friday the 15<sup>th</sup> of April.

Chief Salvatore reported that Officer Tyler Meusel is doing very well at the Academy.

On April 30<sup>th</sup> they are having another unused or expired medication collection. It will be held at 2 p.m. at the Police Station. Captain Kosinski set it up with DEA. The State is going through a State 911 consolidation study. The State will be meeting with him in the near future. The chief is concerned that it won't be a true consolidation study because they are only looking at 911. They are not looking into the other aspects of Dispatching; Records Management, Communications, Dark Stations, prisoner procession and holding. Chief Salvatore is also concerned about the study that this board has endorsed with the other four towns. The other

Chiefs that he has spoken to are also concerned that this report will not take into consideration all the aspects of Dispatching. Chief Salvatore urged the commission to be make sure that all aspects are covered when signing a contract for their independent study.

On March 31<sup>st</sup> the Department did an I Promise Distracted Driving Program with the High School in conjunction with Channel 3. Chief Salvatore stated that it was a well presented program but expressed his disappointment with the low attendance.

A. Waters congratulated the Department, Capt. Kosinski and Officer Penn for the wonderful job they did with that program.
