1. **Call to Order:** Chairman Beatty called the meeting to order at 10:01 am.
2. **Roll Call and Seating of Alternates:** The presence of the above members was noted. Madeleine Lowry made a motion to seat alternates John Whitney and Amanda Thomas, seconded by Joseph Corlis. All were in favor.
3. **Site Inspection for Application #11-14: Material Processing in the Upland Review Area on Parcel 00326300 behind 231 Shunpike Road. Arborio Brothers LLC, owner/applicant.**

Attorney Sal Petrella explained the proposed concrete and asphalt demolition debris processing activity and pointed out existing site features (two existing stock piles and a concrete barrier). Amanda Thomas asked, approximately how much debris material will be brought in? Tim Arborio replied, approximately 1.5 times the amount of the western pile. The members then inspected the existing concrete barrier. Attorney Petrella pointed to the gravel-lined "weep holes" along the bottom of the barrier, and noted that the final plans will show some type of bio-filter to capture dust created during the debris processing and prevent it from running off into the wetlands beyond the barrier.

4. **Possible Vote on "Significant Impact Activity" for Application #11-14.**

John Whitney made a motion to find the activity "not significant", seconded by Joseph Corlis. All were in favor; the motion passed.

5. Adjourn: The meeting was adjourned at 10:20 am.
