- Chief issued a Letter of Commendation to Officer DiMaio for his work in apprehending the Purse Snatcher.
- Another robbery occurred today around 3:00 this afternoon and a Salon on Main Street was robbed on Saturday.
- This weekend on the 16th the Department is having their food drive between 12 and 3 p.m., at Stop and Shop. That evening they are having the Santa's Run Adopt a Family; this year four or five families will be honored.
- Over the past few months the First Selectman Beaulieu and the Chief have been working with the DOT on various issues pertaining to Route 9 and the Arrogoni Bridge. The State is presently reviewing Route 9 from Exits 10

thought Exit 19 for specific changes as well as possibly replacing or adding another bridge. They are looking for suggestions from the Towns that are affected. Some improvements will be done on the lower end of Route 9 on the other side of the Arrogoni Bridge.

- There was a cruiser accident on Saturday night. Two separate investigations are being done; one is a motor vehicle accident investigation the other is an Internal Administrative Investigation to make sure that the officer followed all standard operating procedures and regulations. Different Sergeants are doing the two investigations.
