E. CHIEF SALVATORE'S REPORT

The Incident Analysis's Report was handed out for March.

Chief Salvatore reported that recently two scooters were seized. The best thing to do is to call the police when individuals are observed riding scooters on public streets. Officer McCarter is now on the FTO Program and Recruit Darius is at the Academy, they are both doing well.

Chief Salvatore recognized Detective Ron Cornell, who capped off a 9-month investigation of a local business that was being embezzled by a former employee that embezzled \$134,000 from the company. Chief Salvatore also recognized Officers Kogut and Bengston for a job well done. They served a total of 21 warrants on three individuals for Criminal Mischief for vandalism at Oxford Park.

They continue to have the burglaries on the Southeast side of town. Unfortunately there was a fatal accident on Main Street last week. It is being investigated.

Chief Salvatore gave accolades to the Animal Control Officers. So far this year they have registered 1,440 canines in the Town of Cromwell. This is an all time high. Chief Salvatore attended the Bridge Meeting with the First Selectman at the Chamber of Commerce regarding crossing the Connecticut River. During this meeting, the Chief and First Selectman continued to raise their issues with regards to Route 9 exit 19, additional ramps, Exit 18 and all concerns that need to be raised.
