Recruit Darius graduated from the academy on July 24th and is now in Field Officer Training.

There are a number of Private Duty jobs in Town.

Officer Vandersloot was injured while he was investigated a burglary. He will be out of work for several more weeks.

Chief Salvatore stated that he is concerned about several mis-facts and mis-truths that have appeared in the paper regarding alleged secret meetings.
