Chairman Newton advised the Police Commission that he was informed that on April 9th, Chief Salvatore received the 2007 Arnold Markle Award. The award was presented to Chief Salvatore by Doctor Henry Lee and states; " In recognition of his

achievements in the advancement of training and education in the law enforcement community.

On behalf of the Police Commission, Chairman Newton congratulated Chief Salvatore and stated that they are proud of the work that the Chief has done in this area.
