- Officer Parson's graduated from the Academy last week.
- Officer Tolton started the Academy the week before.
- They continue with a number of major investigations and they are continuing with wrapping up the homicide gathering every thing that the prosecutor will need for court.
- They continue to work the home-invasion case.
- An arrest was made with the Kentucky Fried Chicken case. There are still aspects of that case that need to be looked into.
- They are beginning to plan for the June Travelers Tournament.

A lengthy discussion followed with questions from A. Waters and R. Waters regarding the Police Fleet. Discussion continued with R. Waters questioning whether the Police Department has inventory lists, why a recent article was published in the Middletown Press and who is in charge of the Police Department. M. Johnson complemented the Police Department with their work on the recent homicides.
