A part of that work would focus on connections among those recreational areas. A discussion ensued regarding possible recreation sites to include in the map of Cromwell. John Whitney suggested highlighting the major roadways in town to provide a better picture of

where each recreational area is located. Mr. Popper spoke about researching bike lanes and designations.

Mr. Popper reported that the Farmland Preservation Committee was receiving good press and they are moving forward with that. Mr. Popper stated that we are currently all set and that they were looking out for future grants.
