Renter's Rebate Now Open! April 1st to October 1st 2024.

Renter's Rebate is a State of Connecticut program for Elderly and totally Disabled who meet income levels for a rebate on rent and utilities paid.

Qualified renters must have turned 65 in 2023 or be totally disabled.

Maximum limits are \$43,800 for single and \$53,400 for married couples.

Renter's must apply annually and provide proof of income received in 2023, rent paid, and proof of utility payments (electricity, gas, water, and fuel). Income received can be shown as a 1099 or tax return.







Pilot Program Information


The Town of Cromwell Transfer Station personnel will pick up curbside items for a fee to residents of Cromwell. The items (listed) must be placed curbside to the road where no stairs will impede such pick up.

Items shall be large bulky type items that cannot fit in a normal sedan vehicle trunk. Services can be pre-paid at town hall (cash, check or money order), or at Transfer Station (check or money order is order). Check or money order is accepted at time of pick up.

At this time, pick up days will be limited to **Wednesdays** and **Fridays**. Items must be placed curbside between the hours of **7 AM** and **8 AM**. Do not place items at curbside more than 24 hours prior to scheduled pickup. In the event of inclement weather stuffed or padded items shall be covered by the resident as to not absorb water.

Currently we will not be picking up cast iron tubs, cast iron stoves, brush or yard debris, or any type of home renovation/demolition debris.

Any item not listed must be preapproved for pickup by the Public Works Director or designee.




