**STANDARD AGREEMENT FOR
CONSTRUCTION OF SEWER
FACILITIES BY HOME OWNERS**

HOMEOWNER'S PERMITS

The State of Connecticut allows homeowners to do their own work. However, the homeowner should be aware of his/her responsibilities when he/she Places his/her name on the face of the application, for the building permit, as the person doing the work.

Placing your name on the application indicates that you, and you alone, will do the work and that you will be responsible for your work. No other person, except immediate family (Chapter 193, Section 193-7, B, 5, Code of the Town of Cromwell), either neighbor, friend, acquaintance, or other relative, etc, will be allowed to do the work.

No Public Official will be allowed to design, lay out or otherwise inform you how to do the work of any sewer facility. All responsible Public Officials will, however, inspect your work for compliance with Town Codes and Specifications.
