Directions:

Newington High School:

Route 9 north to exit 29; take right onto Ceder Street, at the 4th light turn left onto Willard Avenue, Newington high school is on your left, take second entrance.

Newington Cancellation Information – Go to www.newingtonsoccer.org, click on field closures on the left hand side.

Millwoods (Wethersfield):

Take the Shunpike or 91 north to Silas Deane Highway. Follow Silas and take a left onto Route 3 (Maple Street). Take Maple Street and turn right on Prospect. Follow Prospect and turn left at Millwoods.

Wethersfield Cancellation Information – Coordinator will call you directly if games are cancelled.

Buckingham Field (Glastonbury):

91 North to Exit 25 (CT-3 towards Glastonbury), Merge onto CT-2 towards Norwich, Take the Hebron Ave (Exit 8) towards Irish American Home Society, Turn left onto Hebron Ave/CT-94, Turn left onto Manchester Rd/CT-83, Field is on your right.

Glastonbury Cancellation Information – Coordinator will call you directly if games are cancelled.

Notes: Spectators are to sit on the opposite side of the field from the players. No one is allowed to sit or stand near the goal line. Players must be wearing shin guards to all games and practices for safety reasons. No jewelry (watches, necklaces, earrings, etc.) should be worn at the games or practices for safety reasons.
