

CROMWELL RECREATION DEPARTMENT RULES OF CONDUCT

The following rules of conduct are to ensure that all coaches, instructors, counselors, parents and participants enjoy the program they are involved in and exhibit and promote proper behavior towards each other.

Instructors/Counselors/Coaches—all Representatives of the Cromwell Recreation Department shall set an example for their participants and parents by:

- Be respectful, courteous, and fair with all children and parents at all times
- This means all must not use abuse language or gestures, make threatening Comments, intentionally harm anyone,
- Provide a safe play situation for all,
- Show good sportsmanship at all times,
- Communicate using words that are age appropriate and constantly update parents on situations if needed
- Treat each child as an individual, respecting the range of emotional and Physical differences among the same age group
- Provide an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol
- Remember that you are working with children and the game/activity is for the Children not the adults

Parents/Adults- parents of children in programs or adults in programs shall set an example to children and others by:

- Be respectful, courteous and fair to all players, coaches, referees and other adults
- At all practices and games and activities
- This means all must not use abusive language or gestures, make threatening Comments, intentionally harm anyone
- Show good sportsmanship at all times
- Communicate with staff of the department if have questions/concerns
- Provide an environment that is free of drugs, tobacco and alcohol
- Remember that the sports leagues are for children of all abilities to learn and Improve not winning at all costs

Children- all children enrolled in programs or sports leagues shall:

- Be respectful, courteous and cooperative with all coaches, instructors, counselors
- And other children at all classes, programs, practices and games
- Be respectful and courteous to all referees, opponents, adults at all practices
- And games and activities
- This means all must not use abuse language or gestures, make threatening Comments, intentionally hurt another person, touch other persons
- Not intentionally destroy property that belongs to another person
- Show good sportsmanship at all times
- Follow all specific rules established for that program/activity/league

For those not abiding to the above rules of conduct, the Cromwell Recreation Department reserves the right to have the person removed from the facility/activity/program
