Ed Maley made a motion to appropriate \$50,000 for the Charter Revision Commission for Contractual obligations out of the CNR budget; Dan Kelly seconded. Discussion followed on a possible need for a professional attorney to help go through the charter top to bottom.

Ed Maley and Dan Kelly voted in favor of the motion. Steve Wygonowski, Brian Stermer and Matthew Blanchette voted against the motion. John abstained. MOTION FAILS.
