The project involves the reconstruction of Coles Road between Route 9 and Route 3 with minor horizontal and vertical realignment, widening of the roadway, installation of bituminous concrete lip curbing, construction of a retaining wall and construction of drainage and concrete sidewalk on one side of the road throughout the length of the project. Proposed sub-consultants and their prior project experience with the prime consultant must be clearly identified. The relationship to any "parent" or any subsidiary firm with any of the parties concerned must be clearly defined.
