

CORONAVIRUS: PERSONAL SERVICES (SALONS, BARBER SHOPS, NAIL SALONS AND THERAPEUTIC MASSAGE)

- Areas should be cleaned prior to sanitizing
- Sanitize door handles, railings, screens, tables and chairs and stations
- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Be sure adequate supplies are readily available in bathrooms and other wash areas
- Disinfect all equipment and utensils using EPA registered products and procedures per manufacturer instructions
- Do not touch your face and wear gloves when possible
- Store all equipment and utensils in a sterile fashion
- Practice universal precautions regarding bloodborne pathogens
- Avoid eating on the premises
- Properly launder all appropriate items
- Use single service equipment and utensils whenever possible

Excluding Workers:

- Exclude any workers with flu like symptoms
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick and encourage those who are ill to stay home
- If you are feeling ill do not come into work
- Stay home if you have a fever greater than 100.4°F
- Before returning to work after an illness you must be symptom and fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medicine
