- The Mayor's Annual Tree Lighting along with the Holiday Stroll will be held on December 1st. The Holiday Stroll will start at 4:30 p.m. and the tree lighting will be a 5:00 p.m. This year the tree lighting will take place on the green across for the Cromwell Police Department.
