Reminder No Leaves in Roadway

In Preparation for the fall leaf pickup season, The Cromwell Police Department wishes to remind residents of the Town not to place leaves in the roadway. One main concern for the Town of Cromwell is the obstruction of passage for motorists by narrowing the roadways.

Property owners or their landscapers should place the leaves on the edge of their property closest to the road so that the Department of Public Works Highway Department can collect them.

The Department of Public Works will announce their Pick-Up Schedule on the Town of Cromwell Website, www.cromwellct.com.

In addition to the curbside pickup, residents may bring their leaves to the transfer station. The transfer station rules and operating times can also be found on the Town of Cromwell Website.

Placing leaves in the roadway can also cause problems during rainstorms with drainage causing clogging and flooding.

Please be advised that the Cromwell Police Department will enforce violations of the Town Ordinance 204-27, regarding placement of leaves on public property of which carries a \$50.00 a day fine with the possibility of additional costs.
