Members of the public are encouraged to attend to voice their ideas, concerns, or to provide feedback on any town related concerns.

Councilwoman Luna mentioned that the Town held a flu clinic in November. She also attended the Town Hall Employees' Holiday Party and the Mayor's Tree Lighting. The Farmer's Market Craft Fair was held in the Town Hall gym and was very well attended. There will be a "Meet the Mayor" event on Friday, December 15th at 9:30 a.m. in the Senior Center.

6. Reports:

Chairman's Report -

Chairman Kathy Newton and Margaret Colella attended the Friends of the Library ornament-Making. The Friends of the Library are having a book sale in May.

Library Director -

Staffing-We are losing a part time employee. She has been offered a position with benefits at the other library she works at. We have the position posted and she has offered to fill in for us. There have been eight or nine applications. The position is open until December 18th.

Tik Tok-The library's Tik Tok account has had two videos go viral. The most popular has 943.9K views as this report is being written. @cbplibrary

Tree Lighting-Anthony Salvatore Jr. and Director Canney attended the tree lighting. We dispersed over 100 food scrap bins and took pictures with the festive photo backdrop.

Strategic Plan-The first draft is complete.

12 Days of Christmas/8 Nights of Hanukkah Book Bundles- These wrapped book bundles were checked out all in one day.

Library Listening Session at the Legislative Office with Lt. Governor Bysiewicz- Director Canney and approximately 65 other librarians from across the state were invited to discuss Intellectual Freedom and the exorbitant cost of e-books. The session was very productive.

Fireplace-Karlyn and Director Canney put together the fireplace by the newspapers. It might be the coziest place in the library.

Friends of the Library-They now have their own Facebook page and had a successful ornament program full of glitter!

Statistics -Director Canney stated that everything is looking great; the door count is up, circulation is up and programming is up. Last month Hoopla was almost \$1,000.

Finance Report -

Director Canney said that the remaining \$27,705.77 of the library's general fund budget has not been allocated; this is right on course.
