Welcome to Cromwell Works, the Mayor and Town Manager's newsletter. Each edition will include current events and information about the Town.

- Just a reminder that the town resident Shred-it day is June 30th from 9 a.m. until 12:00 (or until the truck is full). Please bring proof of residency.
- New spring and summer banners will be going up on Main Street in the downtown district.
- Three trees were taken down on Main Street because they were interfering with the power lines and damaging the sidewalks. They will be replaced in the near future with a more suitable choice.
- The Concert Season continues for July at Frisbee Park from 6:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. July 11th will feature Fabio Crew Jazz & Blues and is being sponsored by Cromwell Pizza and Pasta. July 18th will feature Big Deal Rock. A concert is also scheduled for July 25th, the entertainment will be announced. The cost will be shared by the Town and Board of Education.
