Prescription Drug Take Back Day

Chief Denise Lamontagne announces that on April 28, 2018, the Cromwell Police Department will be taking part in a nationwide Prescription Drug Take Back Day in conjunction with the DEA. The purpose of the program is to prevent increased pill abuse and theft. Representatives from the DEA along with members of the Cromwell Police Department will be collecting potentially dangerous, expired, unused and unwanted prescription drugs for destruction. The program is also designed for environmental purposes so these dangerous drugs are not released into the waterways of Connecticut and are disposed of properly. The service is free and anonymous, no questions asked.

The collection site in the Town of Cromwell will be in The Cromwell Police Department located at 5 West Street, on April 28, 2018, between the hours of 10 am and 2 pm. The only items that will not be taken are intra-venous solutions, injectibles, and syringes due to the potential hazard posed by blood-borne pathogens.
