PROCLAMATION TOWN OF CROMWELL DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Anthony J. Salvatore, Town Manager for the Town of Cromwell, does find:

1. That due to the coronavirus pandemic the Town of Cromwell is facing a dangerous health situation;
2. That due to the pandemic a condition of extreme peril to life exists and thus necessitates a state of emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the Town's Emergency Operation Plan it is hereby proclaimed and ordered that a **STATE OF EMERGENCY** now exists throughout the Town of Cromwell; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said emergency that Anthony J. Salvatore, Town Manager and CEO of the Town of Cromwell shall exercise those powers, functions and duties prescribed by state law, the town charter, and all applicable ordinances, resolutions, special acts, and the town Emergency Operations Plan in order to minimize the effects of said emergency and for the purpose of receipt, processing and coordination of all inquiries and requirements necessary to obtain state and federal assistance.

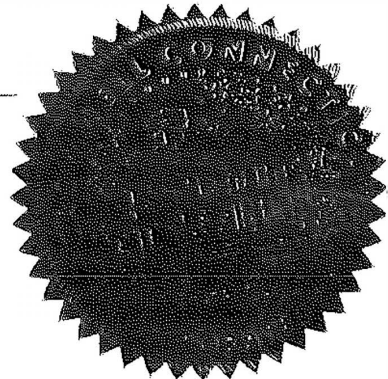
Additional proclamations shall be made as necessary in accordance with the Emergency Operations Plan and state and federal orders relating to the pandemic.

In response to COVID 19 Effective March 16, 2020

TOWN HALL WILL REMAIN OPEN BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

Town Manager in consultation with the Public Health Coordinator issues the follow update effective March 16, 2020;

- All Cromwell Public Buildings will be closed March 17, 2020 except by appointments that are absolutely necessary and time sensitive.
- Board and Commission meetings are canceled unless there is pressing business. Meetings will not be open to the public and will be run in accordance with the Governors Executive Order 7-b.1.
- Parks and walking trails remain open with the exception of tennis and basketball courts and playscapes.
- At this time the Transfer Station will remain open.
- Effective 8 p.m. tonight gathering will be limited to capacities of 50 people, restaurants and bars will be takeout and delivery only. Gyms will be closed. I will be directing the Cromwell Police and Fire Departments to monitor compliance.
- All residential Building Inspections will be limited to outdoor inspections only.
- Senior Transportation is by appointment only and limited to Medical Appointments, Prescriptions and Grocery Stores.
- Donations to the Food Bank are welcome. Please leave them in a cart in the lobby of Town Hall.
- We ask that all residents practice social distancing and good judgement.
