
Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 7-7, a referendum of the electors and citizens qualified to vote in town meetings of the Town of Cromwell, Connecticut, will be held between the hours of 12:00 P.M. and 8:00 P.M. on Wednesday, March 20, 2019, at Cromwell High School, Donald Harris Drive, Cromwell, Connecticut, for the purpose of voting on the resolution presented to the Special Town Meeting held March 11, 2019 that the Town appropriate \$9,300,000 for costs related to the design, construction, furnishing, equipping and relocation of various Cromwell Public Works Department and Cromwell Water Pollution Control facilities. The full text of the resolution is on file and available for public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk during normal business hours. Absentee ballots will be available in the Town Clerk's office.

The resolution will be placed on the ballot under the following heading:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF CROMWELL APPROPRIATE \$9,300,000 FOR COSTS RELATED TO THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, FURNISHING, EQUIPPING AND RELOCATION OF VARIOUS CROMWELL PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND CROMWELL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY OFFICE AND EQUIPMENT STORAGE AND MAINTENANCE FACILITIES, AND RELATED PROJECTS; AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS AND NOTES IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION?”

Voters approving the resolution will vote “Yes” and those opposing said resolution will vote “No.”
