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MINUTES

A. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Faienza called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

B. CITIZENS COMMENTS

None

C. NEW BUSINESS

1. Discussion and action to approve Captain's upgrade.

Mayor Faienza presented this item. This request is being made at this time to compensate the Captain's position for some of the additional duties due to the Chief's appointment as Acting Town Manager. Since this would have been a budget request and become effective in July this upgrade will be permanent upgrade effective March 2, 2015 to Level E-6 Step 6-7.

Motion made by M. Terry seconded by A.Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve the Captain's upgrade to Level E-6, Step 6-7 effective retroactively back to March 2, 2015.

D. BUDGET WORKSHOP

a. Discussion and Action on General Fund Budget Requests:

1. Town Manager \$264,114

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by R. Newton and unanimously carried to approve **\$264,114.**

2. Town Clerk \$233,120

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by A. Spotts to approve. Town Clerk advised the Council the Filming of Land Records line item can be changed to \$25,000, which is a reduction of \$8,000.

Motion made by M. Terry seconded by S. Banic to increase the Town Clerk's (and Tax Collector's) salary by \$5,000 to \$80,246 for the Town Clerk. Discussion followed regarding if the salary for the Elected Officials can be adjusted to the qualifications they bring to the position. Acting Town Manager Salvatore was asked to research this matter.

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by A. Waters and carried to table.

Motion to table carried.

7. Building Inspection \$212,897.

Building Official D. Jolley presented the request.

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by M. Terry and *unanimously carried* to approve \$212,897.

42. Youth Services \$106,540

Recreation Director S. Schein presented the request.

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve \$106,540.

43. Recreation \$264,928

Recreation Director S. Schein presented the request.

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve \$264,928.

22. Committee to Support People with Disabilities \$100

Recreation Director S. Schein presented the request. Ms. Schein advised the Council that this committee has not met for many months. She advised that when there is an open position on the Recreation Commission she will suggest filling the vacancy by appointing a member of the Committee to Support People.

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by A. Waters and *unanimously carried* to approve \$100.

27. Public Works Administration \$246,164.

Public Works Director Spina presented Public Works Requests # 27 - #34. The Capital Improvement request of \$30,000 for the Pavement Management Study was discussed.

Motion made by A. Spotts seconded by S. Banic and *unanimously carried* to approve <u>\$246,164.</u>

28. Engineering \$200,180

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by A. Spotts and to approve. After a short discussion the consensus of the Council was to add an Easement Line of \$2,500.

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by S. Banic and unanimously carried to approve adding \$2,500 Easement Line and approving \$202,680 The Capital Improvement request of \$200,000 for the Drainage at the Police Department was discussed.

29. Solid Waste Removal \$582,345

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by M. Terry to approve.

After a short discussion \$11,107 was added to the Reimbursement Program Line.

Mayor Faienza advised the Council that \$100,000 is in the Revenue Line for Transfer Station Household Permits at \$40.00 per household. The consensus of the Council was to discuss the Solid Waste Report at another meeting. Motion made by R. Newton seconded by S. Banic to add \$11,107 to the Reimbursement Program line and approve the total of \$593,452.

30. Highway Department \$1,247,137

On behalf of the Council Mayor Faienza thanked the members of the Public Works Department for the excellent job they are doing keeping our roads clear. The Capital Improvement request of \$125,000 Mason Dump Truck request was discussed.

Motion made by A. Spotts seconded by R. Newton and *unanimously carried* to approve \$1,247,137.

31. Vehicle Maintenance \$338,122

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by R. Newton and *unanimously* carried to approve \$338,122.

32. Building Maintenance \$567,863

The Capital Improvement requests of \$100,000 for the Town Hall Shingles and \$23,000 for HVAC Software was discussed.

Motion made by S. Banic seconded by M. Terry to approve.

After discussion regarding the Wages Line the consensus of the Council was to reduce the line by \$2,000 due to changes in personnel.

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by S. Banic and *unanimously carried* to reduce the Wage Line by \$2,000 and approve **\$565,863**.

33. Parks & Grounds \$350,271

Motion made by A. Spotts seconded by F. Emanuele and to approve.

After discussion the Council agreed to add \$10,000 to Part Time Wages Line and \$6,000 to the Capital Line for Security System/Watrous Park.

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by M. Terry and *unanimously carried* to add \$10,000 to Part Time Wages Line and \$6,000 to Capital Line for Security System/Watrous Park and approve \$366,271.

34. Public Works – Other Expense \$491,376

A short discussion followed regarding the cost of the delivery fee portion for the Electric Bills. The consensus of the Council was to table this item until the cost of the delivery fee was determined.

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by A. Waters and *unanimously carried* to table.

Mayor Faienza called for a recess from 8:44 p.m. to 8:49 p.m.

4. Economic Development \$20,400

Director of Planning & Development & EDC Coordinator S. Popper presented items #4 - # 26.

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by M. Terry and unanimously carried to approve \$20,400.

5. Town Planner \$142,087

The consensus of the Council was to table this item until after the Executive Session on March 5, 2015.

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to table.

6. Development Compliance \$88,570

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve **§88,570**.

23. Planning Commission \$3,225

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve \$3,225.

24. Zoning Board of Appeals \$_\$1,535

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve \$1.535.

25. Inland Wetlands \$2,185

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by A. Waters and unanimously *carried* to approve \$2.185.

26. Conservation Commission \$1,510

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by A. Waters and *unanimously carried* to approve **\$1,510**.

12. Donations & Dues \$39,820

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve \$39,820.

13. Legal Expense \$175,081

M. Terry was concerned that the amount for the Labor Attorney was not a good estimate because three union contracts will be negotiated next year. After discussion the consensus was to leave the line item as is with the understanding that there may be a request for additional funds if necessary.

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by R. Newton and *unanimously carried* to approve \$175,081.

14. Central Service \$142,300

Motion made by A. Spotts seconded by S. Banic and *unanimously carried* to approve \$142,300.

16. General Expense <u>\$717,343</u>

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by A. Spotts to approve.

A. Spotts requested to remove the \$10,000 put aside for this year's Riverport Festival and to add \$150,000 to the C.N.R. Fund Transfer for a carport at the Police Department.

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to remove \$10,000 from the Riverport Item lines and add \$150,000 to C.N.R. Fund Transfer for a car-port at the Police Department and approve **\$857,343**.

17. Town Council \$32,925

Motion made by M. Terry seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve \$32,925.

18. Board of Finance \$1,650

Motion made by F. Emanuele seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve **§1,650.**

20. Charter Revision Committee \$0

Motion made by R. Newton seconded by A. Spotts and *unanimously carried* to approve \$1.00 to keep the line item open.
