a. Arbor Meadows- Single Family Residential Development @76 Field Road, Milone & MacBroom Inc. will do a Presentation on the Proposed Sanitary Sewer Construction Design. (R. Peck Review Memo) Review and Action

Thomas J. Daly, PE, Vice President Senior Project Manager, Civil Engineering –MILONE & MacBROOM INC presented to the authority the Proposed Sanitary Sewer Construction Design for Arbor Meadows Development at 76 Field Road. Part of the project, a new sanitary sewer line is proposed to connect to the existing sewer main located at the south end of the property near the railroad tracks. The estimated sewerage generated for this project is 20,900 gallons per day (gpd) using a rate of 275 gpd/house based upon the Rutgers University Demographic Multipliers for Connecticut which has 3.64 people per four bedroom single family detached homes and 75 gpd per person. This flow estimate includes connection of the existing house to the sewer.

Mr. Richard Peck told the authority that MILONE & MacBROOM INC has agreed to meet all of his March 1, 2018 memo.

After a brief discussion by Authority Commissioners – a motion was made by Eric Zeilor and second by Robert Jahn to approve the proposed sanitary sewer construction design as recommended by Sewer Administrator Richard Peck. **Motion passed unanimously**.
